FLORA & FAUNA

FLORA

Typical to the tropical rain forest, CFC's the main tree flora comprises mainly of mixed Diptercarp and Non-Dipterocarp tree spices with diversified biological resources. Bamboos, palms, ferns (resam), climbers, rattans and other undergrowths occupy most of the open areas within the forest.



FAUNA

A rapid Assessment on wildlife's occurrence and abundance was conducted during the establishment and inventory of the sample plots in 2001 and re-establishment of permanent sample plots in 2006.

It was found that the forest concession area supports significant numbers of large mammals of which the most commonly detected included sambar deer, barking deer and mouse deer were also recorded. There were also sightings of Malayan sun bear.
