PESAMA supports those suppliers who use sustainable forest management practices, which integrate the social, economic and environmental needs.

PESAMA is committed to ensuring that all our forestry activities are conducted in a manner which will provide a safe environment for all of its employees, business partners, and the general public. It is committed to the development and implementation of environmental friendly systems of work.

The aims of the statement are to:

Meet all applicable Government Codes of Practices and Regulations and evaluate our performance against this legislation and standards.

Establish Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) objectives and targets enable us to continually improve our environmental performance.

Reduce to a minimum any environmental impact that our operations may cause and make use of environmental friendly alternatives for use in our operations and ensure efficient use of natural resources, conserve water, energy, reduce forest waste and forest damage by using of Low Impact Logging (LIL) system such as Logfisher Harvester.

Instill among our workers the awareness of environmental requirements and regulations, particularly in safety and health of the forest workers.

Ensure that any sub-contractors employed by us are competent, so that they do not put operations at risk of a significant environmental impact and aware of our environmental requirements and apply compatible standard and procedure with our own.

RESPONSIBLE POLICY STATEMENT

The Cherul Forest Concession (CFC) not only provides environmental benefits, but also an array of renewable timber products and other uses. It has an inherent responsibility to the environment particularly to the forests and their sustainability.
